## Aerie Big Sky and Aerie International, Missoula

Big Sky High School's <u>Aerie Magazine</u> program is one of only a handful of literary magazines around the world edited solely by high school students that offers a professional publication experience.

#### **Arts Without Boundaries, Billings**

<u>Arts Without Boundaries</u> is a nonprofit organization that facilitates and creates opportunities for students to engage and participate in the arts. By providing students with affordable/free of charge writing, art, and music programs, they strive to reach students in communities across all social and economic boundaries.

## North Valley Public Library, Stevensville

"Captain Hooked on Books," a program of <u>North Valley Public Library</u>, is an interactive program of reading, singing, and dancing for children ages three to five years that reinforces early literacy skills in a fun and creative way.

#### Missoula Writing Collaborative, Missoula

The *In Our Words: Creative Writing Residencies on the Flathead Reservation of the Salish and Kootenai Confederated Tribes* program by <u>The Missoula Writing Collaborative</u> brings writers to reservation schools to help students write and publish poems.
