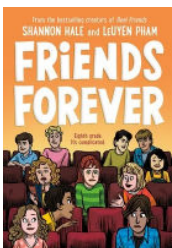
### The Montana Historical Society

The Montana Historical Society was established by the Territorial Legislature of Montana in 1865. It is a collecting and an educational institution.



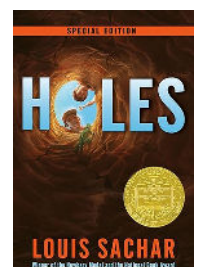

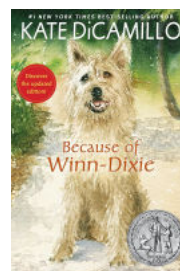
Friends Forever, by Shannon Hale and LeUyen Pham. A story about learning to love yourself exactly as you are.

Holes, by Louis Sachar, is "A dazzling blend of social commentary, tall tale and magic realism." —Publishers Weekly, Starred Review



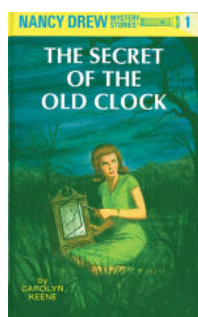
The following texts can be read with The Mystery of Mystic Mountain for a deeper understanding of aspects of friendship and teamwork, loss and grief, history as influence, adventure and treasure hunts, and family dynamics.

Because of Winn-Dixie, by Kate DiCamillo, is a story of a girl who survives the loss of her mother through believing in something bigger than herself.



Wish, by Barbara O'Connor, is middle-grade novel about a girl who, with the help of a true-blue friend, a big-hearted aunt and uncle, and the dog of her dreams, unexpectedly learns the true meaning of family in the least likely of places.

The Mystery of Locked Rooms by Lindsay Currie is an action-packed adventure novel about three friends who team up to find a hidden treasure in an abandoned 1950's funhouse.



The Secret of the Old Clock is the mystery that began it all for America's favorite teenaged sleuth. The accidental rescue of a little girl who lives with her two great-aunts leads to an adventurous search for a missing will.

Treasure Island is a tale noted for its atmosphere, characters and action, and also as a wry commentary on the ambiguity of morality.
