

OVERVIEW

Humanities Montana's Community Project Grants are awarded to nonprofit organizations and public institutions across Montana to support public humanities programming that strengthens vibrant communities and cultures, promotes civic engagement, sparks thoughtful community dialogue, and reflects on the human experience across the Big Sky State. These grants are designed to support a vast array of bold and innovative projects that are meaningful to local communities and inspire timely community conversations – from film screenings and panel discussions to cultural festivals and youth literacy programs and much more.

AWARD

\$2,000 to \$10,000 - 1:1 matching funds required

ELIGIBILITY

Montana nonprofit organizations, local municipalities, and cultural, civic, and educational entities. A **Unique Entity ID** (SAM.gov) and **Federal Tax ID** (EIN) are required to apply.
