OVERVIEW

Humanities Montana's Montana Conversations program supports public humanities programming through its statewide speaker's bureau. With Montana Conversations, trained facilitators and experts lead workshops and conversations on topics like current affairs, untold histories, native cultures, literature, and more. Montana Conversations presentations support public humanities efforts with free programs for all communities across Montana.

Humanities Montana pays Montana Conversation speakers an honorarium, and reimburses travel costs including food, lodging and mileage expenses for each program presentation. Promotional materials including press release and poster templates, and Humanities Montana logos are available for booking sites to utilize with Montana Conservation programs.

CO-PAYMENT

APPLICATION \$75: Montana Conversations are supported by grants, donations, and a minimal co-payment from sponsoring organizations. The co-payment is \$75 and is due at the time of application. Rural and small organizations with limited or unpaid volunteer staff may request a waiver if the co-pay is a hardship.

ELIGIBILITY

Nonprofit organizations, accredited institutions of higher education, state or local government or one of their agencies (schools, libraries, museums, etc.), federally recognized Native American Tribal governments, tribal organizations, community organizations (rotary club, Eagles lodge, etc.), churches, private organizations and businesses are eligible to apply. A Unique Entity ID (UEI) and Federal Tax ID (EIN) is not required but strongly encouraged to apply.

Montana Conversations programs must be free and open to the public.

DEADLINES

Rolling Application Deadline (dependent on funding availability). Applications can be submitted anytime, and are reviewed daily.
