## Public Humanities Grants - RFP PUBLIC HUMANITIES FELLOWSHIPS

## **OVERVIEW**

The Public Humanities Fellowship is a competitive grant program intended to support research in the humanities relating to Montana and the region. Fellowship funds support continuous work on a humanities project for a period of six consecutive months. Fellowship funds may support recipients' compensation, travel, and other costs related to the proposed scholarly research and delivery of a public program in Montana.

Humanities Montana fellowships are not limited to individuals in educational institutions. Independent scholars and writers in various other settings—such as, museums, libraries, and historical associations, or others—are welcome and encouraged to apply.

**AWARD** 

Up to \$4,000 - Matching funds not required

**ELIGIBILITY** 

Humanities Montana awards fellowships to **individuals**, not organizations or institutions of higher education.
